MEC Remarks

- To bring in black youth in the rental space, promoting more black women to own land and buildings in and around KwaZulu-Natal in order to transform the property Industry.
- To develop and encourage the Youth to become Job creators than Job seeks through exposing them to opportunities and programmes available and ensuring they understand how to access these opportunities.
- Opportunity to engage with the youth on their expectations and requests from the Provincial Government.
- To expose Youth in construction on how to become more effective and grow within the Construction Industry



Resolution

- 1. The Department to ensure that 30% is set aside for youth sub-contracting
- 2. A Local Database to be developed for local unemployed youth and small business which participate in construction and the Property Industry.
- 3. The Department must assist with relevant trainings and skills to empower youth to become main contractors.
- 4. The Department of Public works to decentralise offices to local municipalities for easy dissemination of information.
- 5. The Department of Public Works to strengthen the use of social media platforms to share and communicate information for the youth to access



Resolution Cont...

- 6. The Department to provide training on the duties and roles of estate agents.
- 7. The Department to engage financial institutions with regards to youth accessing funds for property acquisition and further develop a unit to assist the youth with financial matters.
- 8. Property and land information to be decentralised in terms of who owns it and how to go about utilizing it.
- The Department to develop a manual on how to obtain and use property within KwaZulu-Natal
- 10. The Department to educate communities and implement the transformation policy



Resolution Cont...

- 11. Eyesizwe Contractor Development Programme (ECDP) to be accessed in all districts and local Municipalities
- 12. The selection Criteria for ECDP to be fair and transparent with the focus on black youth that reside in that Districts.
- 13. Contractors with the same grade must compete with each other and work must be distributed equally to ensure that all the selected contracts get and opportunity
- 14. The Department to explore keeping the applications for the ECDP open through out they year to ensure that no one is left out.
